

CANINE CODE OF CONDUCT

All good boys and girls know there is a way one should paw-perly conduct ones-self in public, both for their own safety and the consideration of other guests, we do ask that dogs and their owners follow a few simple rules while they are staying with us:

Dogs must always be properly controlled and supervised.

Please clear up after your dogs and dispose in the dog poop bins provided - your furry family member welcome pack includes some emergency poo bags just incase.

Not all outside areas of our cottages are completely escape-proof. If your furry friend is a flight risk please ensure they are kept on a lead.

Dogs must not be left unattended in the holiday properties for any reason.

In order to keep the houses in the highest condition for all our guests we ask dogs not be allowed on the furniture.

Guests are asked to clean up after dogs, both inside and outside of the property, or extra cleaning costs may be charged.

We LOVE dogs, but not everyone does, and not all dogs love other dogs. Please be mindful of fellow guests and their pets and remember a dog on a lead or a fellow guest may be nervous of our canine buddies, don't allow your dog to approach other dogs or guests until you are sure of their comfort with the situation.

Our animals are generally not fearful of dogs, many of the Brockholes team have dogs so they have grown up with, and are used to them, which means they will likely be inquisitive. If your dog is an unknown quantity around livestock, or likely to be reactive towards them, please keep them on a short lead at all times.
